The MBA Shipping & Logistics is offered by Middlesex University in partnership with Lloyd's Maritime Academy. The programme curriculum will prepare current and future industry leaders with the skills and knowledge required for the challenge of senior management in the global maritime industry. The programme is delivered by part-time, online distance education over 24 months. Topics covered include maritime administration, ship finance, risk management, economics and trade, maritime law, formulating business strategy, human resource management, executive leadership, international marketing, brand establishment, logistics and supply chain management, project mastery and innovative practice.

Online delivery means applicants can study without having to travel to attend lectures or seminars. The University learning portal provides access to online lectures, group interaction, networking opportunities, reference texts and a variety of e-learning tools.

The final Business Transformation Project requires the MBA student to thoroughly analyse a current issue affecting their company or the sector using real data, analysing a variety of scenarios and presenting a realistic action solution. This project is not only integral to the achievement of programme outcomes but will prove invaluable to a sponsoring company or the student as they forge their next step in the industry.

All applicants are assessed for their ability and suitability against a number of criteria, to determine whether:

- they are ambitious and able;
- they have potential to become effective senior managers and are capable of resulting managerial responsibility;
- they are highly self motivated (the programme is demanding and students who are not totally committed are unlikely to excel);
- they have at least two years of full time work experience post-qualification that enables them to exchange experience and perspectives;
- they can argue effectively and defend their viewpoint; and
- they have a good degree and/or professional qualifications.

Applicants to the course are rigorously assessed for prior managerial experience, academic ability, existing industry experience and the ability to successfully complete and pass the course. The applicant assessment process includes taking input from two referees: one academic and one work-based, as well as detailed scrutiny of the applicant's career and achievements.
