Development of Sustainable Offshore Wind Farm Decommissioning Strategies

Decommissioning Offshore Wind

Due to a lack of experiences neither decommissioning processes of offshore wind farms nor methods how to assess these processes are currently available. Offshore wind farm decommissioning is involved with several challenges; uncertainty about foundation structure dismantling, possible reduced utilization of large cost- and emission-intensive deconstruction and transportation vessels or compounds and quantities of rotor blades that need to be recycled. Offshore wind farms as a renewable energy source should be sustainable over the entire life cycle; decommissioning should also be environmentally-friendly, cost-efficient, safe and publicly accepted. Currently, indicators and procedures for assessing the sustainability of offshore wind farm decommissioning are missing. In the SeeOff R&D project, we are developing an approach for a holistic decision framework that provides a structured procedure for analysing decommissioning processes and for assessing them regarding economic, environmental and social aspects in order to identify sustainable decommissioning strategies for offshore wind farms.
